**Eligibility**

To be eligible for an SBTA Merit Based Scholarship, a student must meet the following requirements:

- ◊ Currently completing his/her senior year in high school with sufficient credits to graduate in the spring term of 2023.
- ◊ Possess a cumulative grade point average of 2.0 or higher on a weighted 4.0 scale.
- ◊ Be a legal dependent of a dues paying member (parent or guardian) of the San Bernardino Teachers Association.
- ◊ Intend to enroll in an accredited two- or four- year college, university, or vocational school during the fall term of 2023.

**Application Instructions**

Please read the application carefully and complete all sections; incomplete applications will **NOT** be reviewed.

- \_\_\_\_\_ All applications are to include a typed personal statement of 500-750 words expressing how your high school experience (academics, athletics, extra-curricular activities, outside activities, etc.) has prepared you for college, why you should be considered for scholarship support, and any other information you wish to share that may be of importance to the selection committee in their evaluation of your application.
- \_\_\_\_\_ Include two (2) letters of recommendation from an appropriate teacher, counselor, and/or administrator who is familiar with your academic performance.
- \_\_\_\_\_ Include with your application an **OFFICIAL TRANSCRIPT (with an official seal)** from your high school, listing your GPA and Class Standing.
- \_\_\_\_\_ If you are unable to obtain a transcript-you must provide an AERIES printout that includes current GPA and Class Standing,
